Sub:- Public Services – HM&FW Department – Enquiry report on Double Puncture Laparoscopic (DPL) Surgery conducted on 25.08.2022 at CHC Ibrahimpatnam, Ranga Reddy District – Take appropriate action - Reg.

2. From DPH&FW, Hyd., Lr.No.SPL/DPH&FW/2022, Dated.06.09.2022.

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In the reference 1st cited, Government have requested Director of Public Health & Family Welfare, Hyderabad to conduct a detailed enquiry in the incident at DPL Camp, Community Health Centre, Ibrahimpatnam, Ranga Reddy District.

2. In the reference 2nd cited, Director of Public Health & Family Welfare, Hyderabad has submitted his report with the following recommendations;

- i. The permanent family planning surgeries i.e. Tubectomy / DPL shall be made an integral part of hospital service delivery system.
- ii. DPL surgeries shall be conducted as fixed day services along with other services given by the hospital. The DPL acceptor shall be kept at least for 24 hrs in the facility for post-operative care mandatorily.
- iii. As per a pre-scheduled calendar, the beneficiaries shall be guided to access services at the hospitals of their choice.
- iv. Concerned supervisor shall make one visit to the house of the beneficiary within 24 hours from discharge and ensure at least 2 more visits within one week on subsequent post operative days. They shall ensure prompt follow up and appropriate referral as per need.
- v. The Primary Health Centre, Medical Officer shall visit all the post operative cases at least once within the first 2 days. The Medical Officer shall ensure Supervisor duly visits the post operative acceptor as per schedule above.
- vi. Superintendent, Surgeon and Deputy District Medical & Health Officer (camp officer) of the Area shall verify the processes as per the SOPs for Pre-Operative, Intra-Operative, Post-Operative care.
- vii. Refresher training shall be conducted for all supervisory staff on the identification of any possible signs of complication of procedure.
- viii. Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare shall put in place a mechanism to assess the DPL surgeons' skills and knowledge once a year by a competent authority.
- ix. The state Team headed by Joint Director, Office of the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare shall review the processes and all activities pertaining to Sterilization services with all FP program Officers, Surgeons, Teams at least once a quarter.
- x. As per SOPs only 30 family planning surgeries are to be performed on a single day by a surgeon / institute.
- xi. The Hospital infection control committee chaired by Superintendents of hospital shall meet every Monday to review the measures on infection control protocols without fail.
- xii. A refresher training course for all the infection control officers and infection control nurses under Director of Medical Education & Telangana Vaidya Vidhana Parishad shall be organized through NIMS, covering the latest infection control protocols and practices.
- xiii. Director of Medical Education and Commissioner, Telangana Vaidya Vidhana Parishad shall ensure implementation of infection control practices with particular focus on OTs and ICUs.
